

**2019 APPLICATION OF SCOTT JAMIESON FOR NOMINATION  
TO BE ELECTED A DIRECTOR OF VANIX**

- 1. Provide a statement of up to 1,000 words in length indicating why you should be elected as a Vanix Director and include relevant biographical information.**

My entire career (25 years and counting) has been spent promoting broadband infrastructure and competitive access to the same. I've also had the opportunity to help build broadband infrastructure (primarily in BC and Alberta) as an entrepreneur, a private sector operator, a public-sector operator, and as a telecom contractor.

Like my fellow Directors, I believe in promoting and supporting this industry in Canada.
